

## Parent and Family Weekend Frequently Asked Questions

### 1. How to I purchase game and Brewfest tickets?

- a. Please contact the UC Davis ticket office at (530)752-1915 or visit their [website](#). Please note that all Brewfest tickets include a game ticket.

### 2. I understand my UC Davis student receives a free football ticket. Can they sit in the same section as me?

- a. Students do in fact receive their own complimentary ticket; however it is for seating in the student section. If you would like to sit in the student section, please ask for a general admission section when purchasing your ticket. If you would like your student to sit with you in a seat in the stadium, you will need to purchase them an individual ticket.

### 3. Do I need a ticket to attend the lectures on Saturday?

- a. Yes. We do ask that you register in advance as seating is limited. Register at our [website](#).

### 4. What does my student need tickets to?

- a. If you would like your student to attend lectures, Brewfest, or Bike Tours they will need to be registered and a ticket purchased for them to attend.

### 5. Parking

- a. Parking is \$9/day and is enforced Monday through Friday and during special events. Parking is free in Lot 25 if you are attending the morning lectures. If you arrive after 12 p.m. parking will be enforced due to the football game. Handicap accessible parking is available in all lots. ### 6. Can I bring my pet with me for the weekend?

- a. No pets (with the exception of service animals) are allowed in any UC Davis buildings.

### 7. Children's tickets.

- a. Children under the age of 10 are welcome to attend the lectures at no charge. Those over the age of 10 will need to purchase a ticket. Additionally, anyone who wishes to have lunch will need to purchase a lunch ticket and all children will need a ticket to attend the football game.

### 8. Where can I stay during parent weekend?

- a. There are many hotels within the city of Davis – however, many hotels may be sold out for this popular weekend. Please visit the [Yolo County Visitors Bureau](#) for list of all Davis hotels as well as good options for the nearby cities of Dixon and Winters There is no campus housing available for Parent Weekend.
